Notice To Players

Play is governed by the current USGA Rules of Golf and its Interpretations, the SOPGA Rules of Play Card, the Local Rules for this event regarding Pace of Play, and the Notice to Players, which applies to this golf course.

Format: 36-Hole Individual Stroke Play

June 29: Two 9-hole stipulated rounds

June 30: Two 9-hole stipulated rounds

Tee Markers: Boys 13-18: White SOPGA Tee Markers
Girls 13-18: Pink SOPGA Tee Markers

Red Penalty Areas: All tall natural grass will be a red penalty area (defined by mow line)

Out of Bounds: Defined by white stakes for property boundary fence

Flower Beds: Treated as Ground Under Repair. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or area of his intended swing, player must take relief under Rule 16-1.

Flagstick: Do NOT touch the flagstick while on the green. Please use the device attached to the flagstick to retrieve your ball after holing out.

Bunkers: Rakes will be removed from bunkers and lift, clean, and place within one-club length remaining in the bunker will be permitted. Please smooth your footprints the best you can after playing from a bunker.

Distance measuring devices: permitted

Scoring Area: Near 18th green.

Scoring will be done live electronically by each group. No official event scorecards will be handed out. Please download the BlueGolf Scorecard App to complete scoring. You have been emailed a code to access the event scoring. This will be further explained on the first tee and first green.

Ties: Will be broken using the USGA regression method.

Competitors in this event are eligible to earn points toward the 2020 SOPGA Player of the Year contests

* Top 24 Boys (13-18) and Top 18 (13-18) Girls will qualify for the Tour Championship
